\*Requires local government support





- ➤ Per Capita Income (80% or less than the national average)
- ➤ Unemployment (1% or higher than the national 24-month average)
- Special Need (Opportunity Zone, job loss, natural disasters, military base closures, underemployment, etc.)




- > Low cost-per-job

### 2019 Disaster Allocation






- 2018 or 2019 Presidentially declared disasters
